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RE: TOP JAW MOUNTING.

- Here is the procedure for mounting / re-mounting TOP JAWS:
- 1) Ensure that all critical surfaces are clean!
- 2) Apply a small amount of moly oil to mounting surfaces of top jaws.
- 3) Mount each top jaw stamped "1", "2" & "3" onto its corresponding master jaw (also stamped "1", "2" & "3") with socket head screws supplied.
- 4) Tighten screws fully to seat each jaw and "squish" out moly oil leaving a fine film between top jaw and master jaw. Wipe away excess oil.
- 5) Back off the top jaw mounting screws and retighten to hand snug such that they have freedom to move, but not lift, upon clamping.
- 6) With the top jaws in the unclamped position, load a plug into the top jaws. Apply clamping line pressure to allow the jaws to come to a fully clamped position this will eliminate any minute gaps between the master jaw pins and their corresponding pinholes in the top jaws. Open and close the jaws 6-10 times leave the jaws clamped.
- 7) Fully tighten the top jaw mounting screws by first tightening the ones closest to the grip diameter. Next, tighten the remaining screws moving outward toward the chuck OD in a circular pattern. Top jaws are now properly loaded.
